## Provence white wines



AOP Côtes de Provence

The nose is fresh and tangy with delicate notes of flowers and lemon. The second nose is discreet and more focused on stone fruits like white peach. There is a hint of salt. The palate is fresh, soft on the attack, almost velvety with notes of stone fruits like juicy white peach and apricot. There is still a nice salinity and floral touches appear on the finish. The finish is long and has a hint of green olive as well as notes of honeysuckle. There is also a hint of bitterness with the lemon zest. Lovely wine.

## Château Coussin 2024

AOP Côtes de Provence

The nose is fresh and fruity with notes of lemon and grapefruit. There is a slight, racy minerality. The second nose opens with notes of white peach and a slight salinity. The palate is fresh and tangy from the start. Lemon and white peach are present. The mid-palate is mouth-watering. The finish is almond-flavored. Simple and effective.
