

## Domaine Coussin La Croix du Prieur rosé

Côtes de Provence

2023

Named in the 18th Century by Jean-Baptiste COUSSIN, Chateau Coussin was purchased by Baptistin Gautier in 1903 and is today run by his descendants, Olivier and Sophie Sumeire who represent the 8th generation of Provencal winemakers.

Domaine Coussin - La Croix du Prieur is produced from the vines classified AOP Côtes de Provence of Château Coussin. The emblematic carved pediment of the façade adorns the labels of the wines produced on the estate.

Silver medal at the Berliner Wein Trophy.

Gold medal at the "World of Rosé" by Vinum.

### TERROIR

A clay-limestone soil is protected from the maritime influence to the South by the Mont Aurélien and enjoys a climate with a mild continental influence. This region is considered to be one of the most natural in France thanks to the drying effects of the Mistral wind which protects the vines from disease.

### VINEYARD

Vineyard of 30 ans

Grenache 50%, Cinsault 30% et Syrah 20%

Yield 50hl/ha

High Environnemental Value certification (HEV) level 3

### VINIFICATION

Low temperature stabilization for 18 days, followed by temperature controlled fermentation in stainless steel tanks.

### TASTING NOTES

A bright pale pink color, enveloping an expressive nose of orange pulp and apricot, a prelude to a well-balanced palate, with a zesty finish.
